WHAT: All night graduation party  
WHERE: Disneyland in Anaheim, California  
WHEN: Thursday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 8:30 p.m. to Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, 8:00 a.m.  
WHO: Seniors and guests who are in 11<sup>th</sup> grade or older  
COST: \$75 per person

**PRICE:** Admission to Disneyland and bus transportation is \$75 per person, which includes round-trip transportation, admission, unlimited use of attractions, dancing, entertainment, souvenir brochures and commemorative photograph. Not included: food, souvenirs, shooting galleries and arcades.

**TRANSPORTATION:** PTSA CONTRACTED BUS ONLY – NO EXCEPTIONS! Students must arrive by PTSA contracted bus to be admitted to Disneyland. No private cars will be allowed.

**BUS RESERVATIONS AND STUDENT CLEARANCE**

**WHO:** Seniors and guests clear of all debts and detention. All Chatsworth High students will be checked.  
**TURN IN:** Attached permission slip with all appropriate sections completed and copy of both senior's and guest's picture ID's attached. Each senior should complete his/her own permission slip. The reverse side of the permission slip is for guests who are not Chatsworth High School seniors.  
**WHEN:** By Tuesday, May 8<sup>th</sup>  
**WHERE:** Parent Center in C-Building or A-6  
**GUESTS:** If the senior is bringing a guest (11<sup>th</sup> grade or older, one guest per senior), both sides of the permission slip must be completed when it is turned in.  
**BUSES:** Groups who want to ride on the same bus must turn in all permission slips stapled together to the Parent Center or A-6. Groups will be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis, as space is available.  
**CLEARANCE:** Seniors who turn in an incomplete permission slip or who owe debts and detention will not be able to purchase a ticket until the permission slip is corrected or the debts are cleared. A list is posted outside of A-6 of both eligible and ineligible students. It is the responsibility of students to check the list and clear any problems in A-6 by Tuesday, May 8<sup>th</sup>. Those who do not clear risk losing their group reservation and the opportunity to attend Grad Nite.  
**PLEASE BE AWARE** that PTSA volunteers are organizing Grad Nite. They may not be at the school every day. Seniors must follow these directions carefully. Every cleared senior and guest who gets his/her permission slip and payment in on time will be able to go to Grad Nite.  
**Follow these instructions! Be on time! Don't miss your Grad Nite!**

**PAYMENT PROCEDURE**

**COST:** \$75 per person cash or check made out to Chatsworth High PTSA  
**WHEN:** Students must have their ID card and pay according to the following schedule:  
Tuesday, May 22 Last names beginning with A – E  
Wednesday, May 23 Last names beginning with F – L  
Thursday, May 24 Last names beginning with M – R  
Friday, May 25 Last names beginning with S – Z  
**WHERE:** Chancellor Hall at lunch  
**A seat will be reserved on the bus for every student who pays on time. Don't be late! Don't be disappointed!**

**After Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup>**, if buses are full, no tickets will be sold. If buses are not full, tickets will be sold until all seats are taken. **CASH ONLY.** No checks will be accepted after Fri., May 25<sup>th</sup>. Group reservations will not be held after Fri., May 25<sup>th</sup>. Tickets may not be re-sold or given by seniors or guests to anyone else. Everyone attending must show picture ID before boarding Grad Nite buses.

**REFUNDS** must be requested in writing. Requests after May 25<sup>th</sup> will be for the price of the Disneyland ticket only – the charge for bus transportation cannot be refunded. Refunds will be in the form of a PTSA check written to the student unless otherwise specified in writing, and checks may not be issued until after the event.

**DRESS:** Students and guests must dress according to Disneyland guidelines. Those dressed inappropriately will not be admitted. See [www.disneylandgradnite.com](http://www.disneylandgradnite.com) for more information.

**BEHAVIOR:** Appropriate behavior and consideration for others is expected of all seniors and their guests to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable evening. Inappropriate behavior may result in a conference with an administrator and affect participation in future senior activities including graduation. All seniors signed a Senior Contract this year regarding behavior, and guests will be held to the same standards. Inappropriate behavior by a guest is a reflection on the senior. No alcoholic beverages or drugs will be tolerated. All students will be checked when boarding buses and again at Disneyland.

**In addition to school standards, Disneyland officials enforce their own rules of behavior, dress and transportation. IF ANY STUDENT OR GUEST BECOMES A SERIOUS BEHAVIOR PROBLEM OR IS DETAINED OR ARRESTED, PARENTS WILL BE CALLED AND REQUIRED TO PICK UP THEIR CHILD FROM DISNEYLAND OFFICIALS OR ANAHEIM LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES.**

**MEDICATION:** If a student or guest needs to bring medication, they must inform the Grad Nite chairperson at least one week prior to the event. The medication must be given to a chaperone when boarding the bus.
