College Application Guidelines

It's Time to Apply to College!

Community College:

Apply online by February of your Senior Year Contact Testing Office about taking any Assessment Exams

California State University (CSU):

- o Applications available online at <u>www.csumentor.edu</u>, October 1st-November 30th. **Deadline is November 30th!**
- List A-G courses taken 9th-11th grade. GPA factors all A-G courses taken 10th and 11th grade only.
- SAT Reasoning (Critical Reading & Math only) or ACT required, taken no later than December of Senior Year. Send best scores to CSU Mentor for all CSU's to receive.
- o Application Fee or fee waiver applied for directly on application

University of California (UC):

- o Applications available online at <u>www.universityofcalifornia.edu</u>, November 1st-30th. **Deadline is November 30th!!**
- Comprehensive application—must list classes (A-G courses taken 9th-11th grade,) activities, awards, work experience. GPA factors all A-G courses taken 10th and 11th grade only.
- SAT Reasoning or ACT and 2 SAT Subject Exams required, taken no later than December of Senior Year. Send best composite scores to one UC campus for all UC's to receive.
- Two Personal Statements (1000 words total)
- o Application Fee or fee waiver applied for directly on application

Private/Out of State Colleges and Universities

- o Deadlines vary (most due by mid-January, but some as early as December 1st)
- Apply online directly at the school's site or through Common Application at www.commonapp.org
- o Comprehensive application must list classes, activities, awards, work experience. GPA factors all classes taken 9th-11th grade; GPA and Ranking taken into consideration.
- Secondary School Report from Counselor (includes Letter of Recommendation and Transcripts.) Must be requested from Counselor at least 2 weeks before application is due!! Please fill out Brag Sheet (completed by you) and have 2 Student Information Sheets (completed by teachers who know you well) returned before requesting a Letter of Recommendation from your Counselor.
- Letters of Recommendations from Academic Teachers are needed (please request in a timely manner, at least 2 weeks before application is due.)
- SAT Reasoning or ACT and sometimes 2 SAT Subject Exams required (check college admission requirements)
- o Applications include several essays and/or personal statements, and in addition to Common Application, may request supplemental application
- Application Fees vary per school, and sometimes fee waivers are available through College Board or other means
